- **Crayola:** Crayola LLC, based in Easton, Pa. is the worldwide leader in children's creative expression products. Known for the iconic Crayola Crayon first introduced in 1903, the Crayola brand has grown into a portfolio of innovative art tools, crafting activities and creativity toys that offer children innovative new ways to use color to create everything imaginable in markets around the world. It also operates Crayola Experience attractions in Arizona, Florida, Minnesota, Pennsylvania and Texas.
- **Crown Media Family Networks:** Operates 24-hour cable networks Hallmark Channel, Hallmark Movies & Mysteries and Hallmark Drama with distribution in the U.S. and Canada. Hallmark Publishing is a leading publisher of uplifting eBooks, audiobooks, and print editions, and Hallmark Movies Now is a subscription-based streaming service.
- **Crown Center:** A real estate development business responsible for managing the 85-acre hotel, office, entertainment and residential complex surrounding Hallmark's world headquarters in Kansas City, Mo. Historically attracting five million visitors annually, Crown Center is a key meeting and tourist destination. Another Hallmark business at Crown Center is Halls Kansas City, a specialty department store.
