Hallmark Cards, Inc. (Hallmark) Paper Commitment

As outlined in Hallmark's <u>Paper Policy</u>, we recognize that paper selection for its products should be considered carefully. Hallmark works to ensure production processes are consistent with this policy, sourcing paper and wood products from well-managed forests, recycled materials, or other controlled sources to help conserve natural resources for future use.

What we have accomplished:

As of June 2025, Hallmark has maintained Triple Certification for 15 years. For over 15 years, Hallmark has collaborated with suppliers to source paper and wood fiber through independent third-party certification bodies. Certifications include Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI), and Program for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC).
