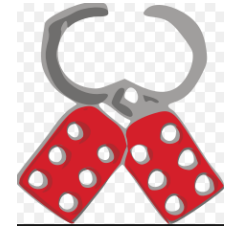

EARN \$40 IN HEALTH REWARDS FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE FREE, ON-SITE WELLNESS SCREENING OFFERED BY HALLMARK HEALTH.

HOW TO REGISTER

- ◇ Visit healthrewards.hallmark.com. If you haven't done so already, you'll be asked to complete an online health assessment that takes 5–10 minutes to complete. (You'll receive 25 additional health rewards points for this step.) When you're finished, click the Hallmark Health logo to return to the home page.
- ◇ From the home page, choose "Step 2: Find/Report a Physician" for instructions to designate the primary care physician you wish to receive your wellness screening results. A physician is required to participate in the screenings. Assistance in finding a primary care physician is available by calling the Cerner Health Navigators at (816) 201-7000 or emailing support@primaryhealthnetwork.com.
- ◇ Last, return to the home page and choose "Step 3: Schedule screening." Follow the instructions to choose the screening date and time that works for you.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

The screening includes comprehensive lab testing and biometric measures (blood pressure, weight, height and waist measurement.) By participating, you and your doctor will receive a confidential report within two weeks that reviews your results and identifies any concern.
