Did you know??? Donations to United Way support the work of the Roger Hill Volunteer Center.

The Roger Hill Volunteer Center opened April 28, 1990, as a program of the United Way of Douglas County. It is named for the late Roger Hill, longtime Lawrence plant manager who was a strong advocate for community service. Before his death, in 1988 at age 49, Roger had been working towards establishing a central clearinghouse for volunteer opportunities. The Roger Hill Volunteer Center opened two years later.

I am excited to announce that on **October 8**th **-12**th we will hold the Lawrence facilities United Way Pledge Drive. Hallmarkers in the new millennium will have the opportunity to continue the vision Roger had for the community.

Every year we get the chance to demonstrate that community spirit and leadership by Living United through giving to the United Way.

<u>Did you know???</u>

- Last year 52.3% of Lawrence Hallmarkers gave to the United Way!
- In the last 4 years we have increased our giving by 6.3%!
- Hallmark will match existing pledges with 50 cents on the dollar and will match new pledges dollar for dollar!

What \$12 can do??? A pledge of \$12 a month (\$144 per year) can provide:

- Blood pressure and blood sugar screenings for 30 seniors at a community service site.
- A two-hour home health visit by a registered nurse or therapist.
- Three specialized therapy sessions for a child who has been sexually abused.
- 11 hours of GED tutoring.
- 60 hours of infant/toddler care.
- 144 snacks for kids in after-school programs.
- 19 one-way trips to prenatal appointments or well-baby checkups.
- 720 meals at a women's shelter.
