2013 Hallmark Health Rewards program close date is approaching

It's still not too late! More than 5,000 Hallmarkers have received over \$300,000 in Hallmark Health Rewards this year. It's been a great success and there's still time for you to participate.

The deadline to report activities or redeem Health Rewards for 2013 is 5 p.m. (CST) Saturday, Nov. 30. Complete instructions are available from the program website.

Remember, you don't have to be a fitness guru to earn rewards. You can earn points for just "knowing your numbers" — receiving recommended preventive care, participating in health education classes, maintaining a healthy BMI and staying active in almost any physical activity you can think of.

If you redeem your rewards before the deadline you may choose to receive them either as a credit on your paycheck or as a gift card from the store of your choice. If you haven't' redeemed all your points by Dec 1, here's what will happen:

• If you have a balance of *less than 10 points*, those points will roll over into the 2014 program and will be available to be redeemed beginning in early January.

If you have a balance of 10 points or more on Dec. 1, those points (in increments of 5) will be automatically redeemed and returned to you as a Premiere Choice Award (redeemable for gift cards from hundreds of merchants nationwide). The Premiere Choice Award is reported as taxable income and tax will be reflected in your December paycheck.
