We produced and shipped 1,500 PDQs between Saturday and Tuesday. That totaled 72,000 retails of plates and 45,000 retails of napkins.

Improvements to Warehouse System

In 2013, Hallmark produced and distributed the largest volume of Christmas roll wrap to this date. The key change that allowed Hallmark to maintain and increase the volume produced is the ability to distribute directly from the Leavenworth facility. This effectively made the Leavenworth facility a pseudo distribution center to deliver product directly to customers. However, with change often come issues that need to be diagnosed and navigated to ensure operations are accurate and smooth.

The major difficulty that arose as a product of direct distribution was accurately maintaining and monitoring finished goods inventory. Since Hallmark's production and distribution operations use two separate inventory systems, documenting product and storage was much more hands on. This led to more errors and in some cases, lost stock. Now in even the worst cases inventory was again accounted for, but the time and movement lost was a cost we wanted to eliminate.

As Christmas roll wrap volumes approached we identified a solution to combat this inventory issue. In order to accurately store product using the tools at hand we had to modify our warehouse storage locations to register in the distribution inventory tracking system, VAX. In order to accurately make such a change there was a significant amount of collaboration between the Enfield, Liberty, and Leavenworth plants. Warehouse storage bays had new identification locations generated and were then labeled with these ID's. This allows operators to scan inventory directly into the system and directly reduce errors. In the next year we hope this change will help improve the process and communication across all levels of the Hallmark supply chain.
