

BENEFITS OPEN ENROLLMENT

Enrollment for 2017 benefits begins Monday, Oct. 31. From Oct. 31-Nov. 11, employees will have access to online tools and support by phone from representatives at Aon and the participating insurance carriers, as well as Hallmark's HR Service Center. The "Help Me Choose" feature of Aon's enrollment website will be designed to make shopping easy. By answering a few questions about personal preferences, each medical plan is given a score — a single number — so employees can quickly see which plans are most compatible with their needs. Using this tool, employees also can compare prescription costs and explore generic and brand-name alternatives. Employees who do not make a new medical enrollment election will be automatically enrolled in the same medical coverage level and carrier they have in 2016, at 2017 prices. The deadline to complete enrollment is Friday, Nov. 11 at 5 p.m.
