Flu Vaccines 2016

Protect yourself and others. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends annual flu vaccines for most people age 6 months and older. Hallmark Medical Departments will be offering the quadrivalent flu vaccine again this year covering four strains of the influenza virus.

There is no out-of-pocket expense for Hallmark employees and their adult dependents enrolled in Aetna, Cigna or United Health Care coverage through the AON health exchange. Medicare eligible retirees and all others are not eligible for reimbursement and will be subject to a \$25 fee.

Your Hallmark Aetna, Cigna or United Health Care insurance card is required.

Keep Facilities Secure: Wear Your Badge

- When entering the building, and at all times inside the building, display your ID badge so others can clearly see it. Make sure your photo is outwardly visible, and do not cover your badge with stickers, the intranet-from-home access card or other items that would block your picture. Badges should be worn between the shoulders and waist (includes around/near waistline such as from pant belt loops or bottom of shirts/sweaters).
- Do not let anyone else use your badge to access the building or a restricted area.
- Do not let anyone follow you through secure doors.

• If your badge is worn, unreadable or damaged, please contact security at your location to obtain a new badge.

• Report a lost or misplaced ID badge immediately by calling the security department at your location.

All full-time Hallmark employees are issued an employee number, and like Social Security numbers your employee number is used for many things in the plant. If you do not know your employee number, ask security or Lisa Allen. Once you have your number please memorize it!
