UNION STATION FOR LUNCH VISIT SPACE ON MARCH 11TH AT THE ARVIN GOTTLIEB PLANETARIUM

Built in 1914, Union Station has been a working train station for millions of travelers. It was extensively remodeled and reopened in 1999 with its majestic Grand Hall, three 3,500-pound chandeliers, and six foot wide clock hanging in her central arch. Union Station is also home to traveling exhibits, Science City, a giant 3D Extreme Screen Theatre, and many other attractions and events each year for visitors of all ages.

Our outing will begin with an 11:00 am show in the Arvin Gottlieb Planetarium on the station's lower level. The planetarium's 60-foot dome was recently upgraded and is now one of the largest and highest resolution planetariums in the Midwest. We will watch the CAPCOM GO! THE APOLLO STORY which lasts about 30 minutes. Then we will move up to the main level and eat lunch at Harvey's at Union Station in the middle of the Grand Hall.
