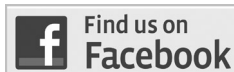

4. After successfully passing the interview, the candidate will be asked to submit a pre-paid background check online.
5. After successfully passing the background check, the volunteer will be contacted to attend volunteer orientation.
6. After orientation, the volunteer will have role-assignment training experience with a volunteer mentor.
