

## WALGREENS & GOLD CROWN GIFTWRAP CHRISTMAS SHIPPING

Excitement and activity began on the 3rd floor on 8/25 with the startup of both Walgreens shipping and the Gold Crown order filling at the same time. We will be shipping a total of 225 trailer loads of roll wrap and tissue case packs over the next 3 weeks to 13 Walgreens distribution centers. Our goal is to have the majority of Walgreens shipped by 9/20. Currently we are shipping about 12 to 15 trailer loads a day. We are utilizing a crew of about 10 people, both full time Hallmarkers and Addeco's to accomplish this feat. Beth Crockett is our clerical support who is scheduling all 225 trailer loads among other responsibilities.

We currently have about 30 people filling Hallmark account orders with Xmas Giftwrap on the ROP (retail order processing) line. We expect our population to grow to about 40 people before we are complete. Again this is a combination of fulltime Hallmarkers and Addeco's. We are currently filling 4 to 5 Fed Ex trailers a day to get our product out the door, and expect this pace to last until early November. Special recognition goes to Mary Schnatz from Liberty, who drives in everyday to conduct our training and to help us assure we are order filling and shipping correctly. There are multiple individuals behind the scenes we have not mentioned that are a huge supporting cast, and critical to our success. Thanks so much to everyone involved.

### What do I have to do?

Making an appointment is easy! Simply log on to "www.savealifenow.org" and follow the steps below.

### Step 1:

If you are a new CBC donor, locate "Never donated with CBC but want to schedule an appointment? Click here to sign up." You will then create a donor profile, username, password and security questions (used only to reset your password should you forget it). Complete registration by enrolling in CBC's Save a Life Rewards program. To enroll, click the Enroll Now! link located in the gray box on the right side of your screen.

If you have donated with CBC but never used the online appointment system, locate "Already donated but don't have a login? Click here to setup your CBC login." You will then create your CBC account; this is done by verifying your identify with either your

Donor ID number (located on your CBC donor card or key tag) or the combination of your last name, date of birth and email. Check your email for a message confirming your account. Click the link in the email to complete the set-up by creating your CBC username, password and security questions. The final step is enrolling in CBC's Save a Life Rewards program. To enroll, click the Enroll Now! link located in the gray box on the right side of your screen.

If you have donated with CBC and used the online appointment system, simply login using your Donor ID and password. You will then create a new username, password and security questions (used only to reset your password should you forget it). Complete registration by enrolling in CBC's Save a Life Rewards program. To enroll, click the Enroll Now! link located in the gray box on the right side of your screen. Already created your CBC username and password? Simply login and schedule your appointment.

### Step 2:

Click the "Continue and View Blood Drives" button to see our blood drive. If you went to the site without using the link and don't see our drive, enter hallmarkcards1 where it asks for the sponsor code (Quick Search). Click the circle to the left of the day you would like your appointment. On the next page, pick a time. Then you will receive an email confirming your appointment. Thank you in advance for your life-saving donation!

- CPR and first-aid training for two staff members working with youth. •
- One month of weekly play-therapy sessions for a child who has experience trauma. •
- A one-month supply of paints, papers, storybooks, puzzles, hands-on science materials and other learning supplies for an early childhood classroom.
